Welcome to Year 4

Welcome to Year 4! We are pleased to be back in school and look forward to the year ahead together. You are invited to a year group meeting on **Monday I I**th **September** straight after school. During this meeting you will have a chance to meet us and we will discuss the routines and expectations for Year 4 and answer any questions you may have about the year ahead. Please do not worry if you cannot attend as we will make all information available on our school website.

<u>Reading:</u> Every child will be allocated a reading book to take home. Reading books and records should be brought into school daily. Please read with your child at home and record it in their diary and we will do the same in school.

<u>Spellings/Homework:</u> Children will be given weekly spellings and times tables to learn. Your child will receive an overview of their spellings and times tables at the beginning of each half term. There will be a spelling test and a multiplication test every Friday.

Water bottles and snacks: It is important for your child to have a named water bottle in school every day. Water bottles should be filled with water **only** please and brought home at the end of the day to be cleaned and filled with fresh water ready for the following day. Children are free to bring in a healthy snack from home to eat at play time.

P.E days:

PE will be taught on a Monday and Friday this half term. Please send your child to school dressed in their PE kit on these days. PE kits should consist of a plain white t-shirt, black/dark blue shorts, dark joggers, school jumper or cardigan and trainers for outdoor games.

Jewellery: We ask that children do not wear any jewellery, including earrings, in school. If your child has recently had their ears pierced and cannot take their earrings out, we ask that they wear simple studs and you provide plasters to cover them during their PE sessions.

Residential: We will share information about the Y4 Delamere residential at a later date.
