#### **School Lunches Price Rise**

Unfortunately, we have been informed that school lunch prices are going to rise to £2.89 from the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2024. We are assured by Edsential, (our 'not for profit' catering company), that rises have been kept to an absolute minimum and are to cover increased costs whilst providing good quality food, meal choice, and fair terms for their staff.

#### Is your child Eligible for Free School Meals and the Pupil Premium?

Some families who currently pay for their child's school meal may be entitled to receive free school meals. If your child is in Reception and Key Stage I they receive a 'universal' free school meal every day, but they may also be entitled to receive Pupil Premium funding. This is an amount of money paid to school for children in families who qualify for free school meals that we are able to put towards improving their education.
